

# ***Upper Canada District Canadian Horse Breeders' Member Recognition Program***

***Beginning January 1, 2018***

**Goal:** To encourage UCD members to enjoy their registered Canadian horses and to promote the Canadian horse breed through involvement in community and UCD events.

**Program Features:** Members may amass points through various types of individual activities (e.g. all forms of riding/driving/dressage) and by participating in group events such as trail rides, parades, fairs, and horse shows in order to showcase the Canadian breed.

The UCD will issue certificates and/or medals to registered participants who will submit an annual, signed summary of their activities. Points are cumulative from year to year.

Points will count only from the date participants have paid their annual UCD membership.

**Point System:** Points will be awarded on the following basis:

1 point for each hour that the participant spends riding/ driving /using their horse(s) up to a maximum of 75 points per annum.

10 points for each UCD event at which the participant volunteers but does not bring a horse.

20 points for each special event in which the participant's horse/s takes part e.g. clinic, parade, Canadian horse demonstration, group trail ride, or organized horse/show competition (e.g. local fair).

20 points will be awarded to any individual for the completion of 1 year as a UCD Director after January 1, 2018.

30 points for taking part with horse/s in the annual UCD Futurity and Show

## **Reward Levels:**

100 points – Certificate of Achievement

200 points – Bronze medallion

300 points – Silver medallion

400 points - Gold medallion

500 points – Platinum medallion
